Multiplying Disciples Among Malaysia's Unreached

Executive Summary

The year 2026 continues with extraordinary momentum. February marked a month of deepening roots and expanding reach — from a divine appointment with a receptive Muslim seeker in Kuala Lumpur, to field equipping visits in Kampar, cross-cultural mobilization in Penang, and the near-completion of our Zúme Bahasa Malaysia translation.

We are witnessing God faithfully multiply disciples across urban and rural contexts: a Georgetown Zúme group member is now returning to Mainland China to plant new 3/3rds groups; a South African teacher in Vietnam is being equipped to disciple her students; and local leaders across Perak, Kelantan, and Penang are stepping into their calling. We remain humbled and grateful for every open door.

Key Ministry Activities — February 2026

1. A Devout Muslim Brother Opens His Heart to the Gospel

By God's grace, we had a divine appointment in Kuala Lumpur with Abdullah, a hardworking brother from Bangladesh. Abdullah is a devoted Muslim who prays five times daily — yet when we stepped out in faith to share the Gospel, he listened gladly and told us openly: "I hope I can know more about Jesus."

For a devout Muslim to express such openness to Christ is a remarkable miracle. We are praying earnestly for his continued journey.

Prayer Requests

- *For revelation — that Jesus would reveal Himself to Abdullah, perhaps through a dream or vision.*
- *For the seeds planted — that the enemy cannot steal the gospel truth he has heard.*
- *For salvation — that his hunger to know Jesus grows and leads to new life in Christ.*

2. Field Visit & Leadership Development — Kampar, Perak

In line with our 4-phase mission strategy, we conducted a field visit to Kampar to strengthen Brother Zamri's leadership network. The focus was on transitioning from training to active deployment using the MAWL principle (Model, Assist, Watch, Leave).

We facilitated a strategic planning session with Brother Zamri to refine his team's outreach goals, and emphasized Peer Mentoring as the foundation for long-term health in his disciple-making movement.

Prayer Requests

- *For Brother Zamri's continued faithfulness and endurance as he shepherds his 7 group leaders.*
- *For the Kampar leadership team to multiply organically across their local network.*

3. Divine Appointments & New Partnership in Kampar

During our Kampar visit, God orchestrated a meaningful connection with Sister Vera — a veteran missionary with over 20 years of service with OM on the Logos Hope ship. She has returned to her hometown and opened a Christian bookstore to serve the local community.

We shared mission stories, cast vision for the Orang Asli ministry, and connected Sister Vera with Brother Zamri to explore a future partnership on the ground. God's timing was perfect.

Prayer Requests

- *For God's blessing and provision over Sister Vera's bookstore ministry.*
- *For a strong, unified partnership between Brother Zamri and Sister Vera.*

- *Thanksgiving — for bringing experienced, passionate workers together in Kampar!*

4. Paul is Training a New Zúme Student — Brother Christopher

Our disciple Paul has begun training Brother Christopher at a local café — a beautiful picture of multiplication in action. We praise God for Paul's commitment to invest in others, and for Christopher's hunger to grow in his knowledge of God and disciple-making.

Prayer Requests

- *For God to transform Brother Christopher — deepening his faith and equipping him to disciple others.*
- *For Paul to be a faithful and encouraging trainer.*

5. From Penang to Vietnam — Equipping Sister Riana

At a café in Penang, we had a wonderful divine appointment with Sister Riana, a South African believer who teaches English at an international school in Vietnam. Because most of her students are non-believers, we encouraged her to see her classroom as a primary mission field.

We introduced her to the 3/3rds disciple group model and challenged her to launch her own groups in Vietnam. We also invited her to partner with us for future ministry work in Malaysia.

Prayer Requests

- *For boldness and wisdom as Riana steps out to start 3/3rds groups with her students in Vietnam.*
- *For her students' hearts to be open and receptive to the Gospel.*
- *For God's provision for Riana to visit Malaysia again and partner with our mission work.*

6. East Coast Mentorship — Kota Bahru, Kelantan

We are maintaining a high-touch mentorship rhythm with Sister Joyce Kok as she works to establish a Gospel foothold in Kota Bahru. Through ongoing Zúme Mandarin Training, she is being equipped with tools for indigenous church planting.

Sister Joyce is currently in the "Launch" phase — preparing to initiate her first 3/3rds Disciple Group. We are finalizing a field support visit for April or May 2026, which will focus on "Watching" and "Assisting" (MAWL) as she begins grassroots ministry.

- **Key Objective:** Transitioning Sister Joyce from trainee to practitioner.

Prayer Requests

- *For Sister Joyce's spiritual protection and steadfastness as she launches her first 3/3rds group.*
- *For receptive hearts among her community contacts in Kota Bahru.*

7. CNY Mobilization — From Georgetown to Mainland China

During our Chinese New Year fellowship, we celebrated a major milestone with our Georgetown Zúme Training Group. This cohort of six Chinese immigrants at The Summerplace has successfully completed all 15 sessions and has transitioned from "hearers to doers" — consistently practicing Prayer Walking and SOAPS Bible study.

The impact of this group is now extending internationally: one member is returning to China with the specific mission to plant three new 3/3rds groups using the Zúme curriculum. This is a direct fulfillment of our digital mission and multiplication goals.

- **Strategic Shift:** Moving from local training to cross-border deployment.



Prayer Requests

- *For the brother returning to China — protection, boldness, and faithfulness as he reproduces these groups in a restricted-access environment.*
- *For the remaining Georgetown group members to continue growing and multiplying locally.*

8. Zúme Bahasa Malaysia (BM) Translation — Near Completion

We are approaching a critical infrastructure milestone: the full translation of Zúme discipleship materials into Bahasa Malaysia. Led by Brother Paul and Brother Chad, the translation is now in its final stages.

- **Progress:** Website and written content are 95% complete.
- **Next Phase:** Professional BM voice-overs for the full 20-session training video series.
- **Strategic Impact:** This localization is essential for deploying workers to the East Coast, Southern Thailand, and Orang Asli ministry networks.
- **Target Completion:** March 2026.

9. Cross-Cultural Mobilization — Equipping the Indian Diaspora

We are encouraged by a strategic new connection with Brother John Abhishek, a passionate believer from India currently residing in Malaysia. John's heart is aligned with our mission to reach unreached people groups, particularly the local Indian community.

During our meeting, John brought his Hindu friend Sunny, creating a direct opportunity to model gospel sharing through personal testimony and prayer. John has expressed a strong desire to partner with our mission programs and intends to join the next Zúme training cohort.

- **Next Steps:** Enrolling John in the next Zúme cohort and establishing a formal accountability partnership.



Prayer Requests

- *For Sunny's heart to be fertile soil for the Gospel.*
- *For John's humility and growth as he enters Zúme training.*
- *For this partnership to strengthen our reach into Malaysia's Indian diaspora.*

- **East Coast:** Finalizing dates for field support visit to Sister Joyce in Kelantan (April/May 2026).
- **Discipleship:** Supporting Brother Christopher's training under Paul; enrolling Brother John in next cohort.

Closing Reflection

As we close the second month of 2026, we are in awe of what God is doing. From a Muslim seeker in Kuala Lumpur to a Chinese brother preparing to plant churches in Mainland China, from a South African teacher equipping students in Vietnam to veteran missionaries uniting in Kampar — **God is moving among the unreached, and He is graciously inviting us to participate.**
