Executive Summary

April 2026 has been a month of remarkable breadth and depth. From launching a Cantonese Zúme cohort with 35 committed students, to forging new gospel connections in Singapore, Bangladesh, Southern Thailand, Hong Kong, and Indonesia, God has been opening doors faster than we can walk through them. The Zúme Bahasa Malaysia translation is now 80% complete in video, and the East Coast field visit is confirmed for May. Our generational discipleship network continues to multiply — and we remain deeply grateful for every partner who prays, gives, and stands with us.

Key Ministry Highlights

1. Zúme Bahasa Malaysia Translation — Nearly Complete

All written content and the Zúme website are 100% complete. We are now recording professional BM voice-overs for the full 20-session video series. Target: April/May 2026. Once released, this opens deployment across East Coast Malaysia, Orang Asli networks in Perak, and Southern Thailand. The works are almost 80% completed for Zume BM video and sub-titles. We will continue to work on it.



Pray for completion of the BM voice-overs by April/May 2026 and swift, wide deployment among BM-speaking communities and Orang Asli networks.

2. East Coast Deployment — Kelantan

Sister Joyce is faithfully serving in Kota Bahru and her first 3/3 group is now in the launch phase. We have confirmed a field support visit on May 7–11, 2026, walking alongside her in the MAWL process as she steps from trainee to practitioner.

Ready to go East coast as plan and look forward God will open the doors for more evangelical works and open people heart to listen the gospel.



Pray for Sister Joyce's spiritual protection and fruitfulness as she launches her first group in one of Malaysia's most challenging mission fields.

3. Zúme Alumni Leadership Network — BM, English and Chinese groups

We are launching a monthly peer mentoring network for all Zúme graduates: April 14 (BM/English) and April 15 (Mandarin). Format: 3/3 Look Back · Look Up · Look Forward, focused on Lessons 15–20 (Leadership & Multiplication). This network is designed to sustain and deepen the disciple-making culture across our entire movement.

Wonderful meet up with our leaders and look forward to pray and support each others to continue to stay faithful in Christ.



Pray for strong commitment and attendance, genuine fellowship, and a renewed hunger for multiplication at both April gatherings.

4. Cantonese Zúme Cohort — 35 Students, Daily SOAPS Accountability

Our Cantonese Zúme cohort is bearing extraordinary fruit. In April alone, we completed Sessions 1–4 with 35 passionate participants. Beginning in Session 2, the group adopted a daily SOAPS (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer, Share) practice — working through James, Titus, and now Romans. They are so hungry for God's Word that they requested daily SOAPS readings assigned all the way through to December 2026, covering Romans, Ephesians, Hebrews, and Psalms. This is true accountability in action. I am personally joining them in the daily SOAPS rhythm, submitting my own devotional notes to the group each day.



Pray for the 35 Cantonese students — for sustained hunger, faithful daily SOAPS practice, and for each one to become a disciple-maker within their own circles.

5. Cantonese Zúme Training Resources — Now Complete

All previously missing and incomplete Zúme Cantonese videos and PowerPoint slides are now finished. Soojin worked faithfully to compile and complete the audio and video materials, and we now have the full Cantonese Zúme training suite ready for deployment. This is a major milestone for reaching Cantonese-speaking communities across Malaysia, Hong Kong, and Mainland China.



Pray for the wide deployment of the Cantonese Zúme resources — that every completed session reaches hungry disciples across Malaysia, Hong Kong, and China.

6. Indonesia Mission Planning — Medan & Palembang

We are in active conversation with missionaries and church leaders seeking Zúme training in Medan and Palembang, Indonesia. I am planning to bring 2–3 Zúme BM alumni leaders to join the deployment, combining Zúme training with direct evangelism outreach to unreached communities. Indonesia represents one of the most significant expansion opportunities on our horizon.

 Pray for open doors and clear timing for the Indonesia trip — for the right team to form, for receptive local leaders, and for this to become a lasting Zúme training hub.

7. China Partnership — Xinjiang Pastors at MBTS

A group of pastors from Xinjiang, China are currently in Kuala Lumpur on a short-term study program at Malaysia Baptist Theological Seminary (MBTS). They connected with us and have formally requested Zúme training program information. This opens a significant door for discipleship training in one of China's most restricted and spiritually needy regions.

 Pray for the Xinjiang pastors — for wisdom as they receive Zúme training, courage to deploy it in a restricted environment, and multiplication of disciples across their region.

8. Southern Thailand Connection — Betong & Hat Yai

We had a meaningful meet-up with a group of believers from Betong and Hat Yai in Southern Thailand. They are excited to learn more about Zúme and see its potential for their communities. Sister Nathanatch will continue as our key follow-up contact, coordinating opportunities for a training visit, fellowship gathering, and evangelism outreach in Southern Thailand.

 Pray for the Southern Thailand believers — for an early opportunity to conduct Zúme training there, and for Sister Nathanatch's faithful follow-up to bring this door wide open.

9. Hong Kong Expansion — Elder Godwin & Brother Nelson

Word has spread among the Hong Kong believer community about our Cantonese Zúme cohort. Elder Godwin and Brother Nelson expressed a keen desire to participate in the near future. I will connect them directly with our existing Hong Kong participants, further strengthening the network of Cantonese-speaking disciple-makers in the region.

 Pray for Elder Godwin and Brother Nelson — for a smooth connection into the Cantonese Zúme cohort, and for the Hong Kong network to deepen and multiply.

10. A Heart Open to Jesus — Brother Abdullah from Bangladesh

Brother Abdullah, a devout Muslim from Bangladesh currently living in Kuala Lumpur, came to visit us this month. Though he is a practicing Muslim, his heart is remarkably open to learning more about Jesus. We pray earnestly for his salvation and for his family. God is at work in ways we cannot fully see.

 Pray for Brother Abdullah — for divine revelation of who Jesus truly is, for the seeds planted to take deep root, and for his whole family to come to know the living Christ.

11. Campus Outreach — Fellowship with Chinese University Students

We completed a Campus Crusade fellowship gathering with a group of Chinese students, many of whom are non-Christians. Brother Michael, visiting from the UK, was invited to share his powerful personal testimony. The students were genuinely moved, and several expressed openness to further conversations about faith in Christ.

 Pray for the Chinese students who heard the Gospel this month — for follow-up conversations, for salvation, and for new disciple groups to emerge from this campus outreach.

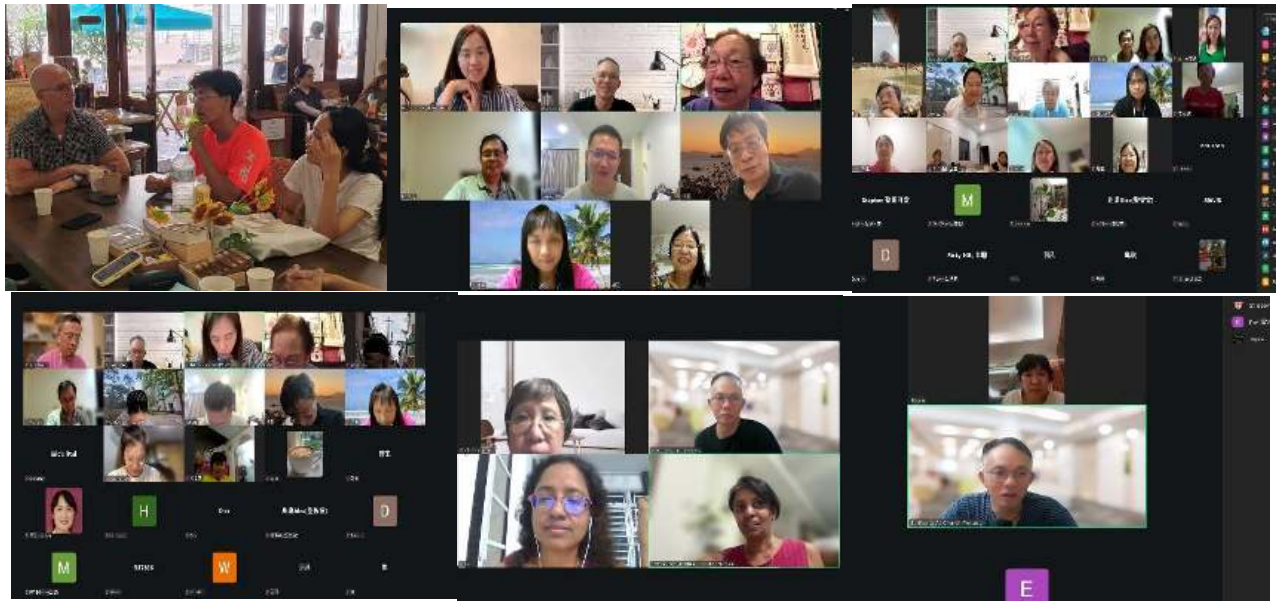
