Faithful Seed-Sowing Among Malaysia's Unreached

1. Grateful Reflections

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...” — Matthew 28:19

June 2026 was a month of faithful seed-sowing — across kampungs, churches, and borders. We give thanks for an 8-day mission trip to Johor, a teaching visit to Jakun tribe believers in Kampung Kuala Sengka, a Father's Day celebration with 80 believers in Sungai Siput, and an open door to preach the Great Commission at Patani Baptist Church at Sungai Petani, Kedah. Five new lives were claimed for Christ this month — D., C., Q., W.J., and KD. We give God all the glory.

Highlights

- Johor Mission Trip (June 1–8):** A full week in the field — training, preaching, and home-church visits across Batu Pahat and surrounding kampungs.
- Zúme Intensive, Batu Pahat:** 25 people trained in an 8-hour discipleship intensive. Follow-up groups are now forming.
- Kampung Kuala Sengka (Jakun UPG), June 7:** Preached to Jakun believers and new friends — continued fruit from the Kuala Sengka UPG relationship.
- Local Church Visit, Batu Pahat:** Shared about mission and discipleship training with the congregation, laying groundwork for future Zúme training in Johor.

- **Sungai Siput — Father’s Day, June:** Preached at a Father’s Day dinner celebration with 80 members from a local partner church.
- **Patani Baptist Church, June 20:** Preached and shared the Great Commission — an open door toward the Southern Thailand UPG corridor.
- **5 Professions of Faith:** D., C., Q., W.J., and KD came to Christ this month.

Prayer Requests

- For the 25 newly trained believers at Batu Pahat — that they would form healthy 3/3 groups and begin multiplying.
- For D., C., Q., W.J., and KD — that their first steps in Christ would take deep root.
- For continued favor and open doors at Patani Baptist Church and across the Southern Thailand border.
- For the Jakun believers in Kuala Sengka — protection, growth, and multiplying disciples among their own people.

3. Heritage Café & Mission Hub

Our Heritage Café and Mission Hub continues to be a quiet front door for the Gospel in our community. In June, we welcomed and served 1,200 visitors who walked through our doors — some for coffee, some for conversation, and some who left as changed people.

4. Active Groups Update

Zúme discipleship training is now running concurrently in four languages, each carried by a growing local leadership network.

Zúme Mandarin — New Cohort (started June 16)

- 14 students total: 9 from China, 5 from Malaysia.
- Leaders: So., Jo.

Zúme Cantonese — Ongoing

- 35 students currently in training.
- Leaders: Dr. L., A., M., E.C.

Zúme English — Ongoing

- 3 students meeting in person at a local café.
- Leaders: Em., Cr., Mt.

Zúme Bahasa Malaysia — Leadership Network

- Leaders: K., Sa., Z., B.
- With 25 leaders and members under their care in Kampar and Ulu Kampar, Perak.

5. Prayer Requests / Next Steps

Next Steps

- Follow up with the 25 newly trained leaders at Batu Pahat — begin forming 3/3 groups.
- Disciple and establish the 5 new believers (D., C., Q., W.J., KD) in their first steps of faith.
- Continue the Mandarin cohort (China + Malaysia) through its first full cycle.
- Explore next steps with Patani Baptist Church toward sustained Southern Thailand UPG outreach.
- Prepare for the Indonesia (Medan) deployment groundwork continuing toward October 2026.

Prayer Requests

- For continued open doors across Johor, Perak, and the Thai border region.
- For the four language leadership networks — endurance and unity as they carry their cohorts forward.
- For the steady stream of visitors at Heritage Café & Mission Hub — that conversations would turn into changed lives.
- For Pastor Jony's strength and protection in continued cross-border travel.

Closing Reflection

June 2026 leaves us in awe. From a kampung classroom in Kuala Sengka to a church platform at Sungai Petani toward the Thai border, and from 1,200 conversations over coffee at our own Mission Hub, God kept opening doors faster than we could walk through them. Twenty-five new leaders were trained. Five new friends gave their life to Jesus. And across four languages — and one café counter — ordinary people kept choosing to make disciples who make disciples.

Thank you for praying, giving, and going with us. You are a vital part of every group that meets, every prayer answered, and every soul that encounters the love of Jesus.
